### **ORDINANCE NO. 1177-111521**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING & ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE OGLESBY AMBULANCE SERVICE

WHEREAS, the City of Oglesby employs an Ambulance Service Executive

Director and other employees in the Oglesby Ambulance Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oglesby desires to establish amended wage rates for the Ambulance Service Executive Director and other employees in said Department which are not covered by a collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-5-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-5-7) authorizes the corporate authorities of the City of Oglesby to operate an ambulance service and to employ persons to work for the City in said Ambulance Service; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Oglesby deem it to be in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Oglesby to adopt an ordinance establishing amended wage rates for the Ambulance Service Executive Director and other employees in said Department not covered by a collective bargaining agreement as stated herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF OGLESBY, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** RECITALS: The recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are restated and incorporated by reference as if set out in full herein.

SECTION 2. WAGE RATES: Effective and retroactive to May 1, 2021, the salary of the Oglesby Ambulance Service Executive Director shall be increased to Fifty-nine Thousand, Five Hundred and no100 Dollars (\$59,500.00) and the rate of compensation of the Ambulance Department's EMT's (including call outs and on call hours) and any other Ambulance Service personnel shall be increased by the rate of three percent (3%). All other benefits and job requirements for said positions shall remain the same.

In addition, commencing May 1, 2022, and on May 1<sup>st</sup> of each of the two successive May 1<sup>sts</sup> thereafter, to end on May 1, 2024, said employees shall receive a three percent (3%) annual rate increase.

**SECTION 3.** SUPERSEDING PRIOR WAGE RATES: The rates set forth in this ordinance shall supersede any prior wage rates set forth for the positions and persons specified herein, from an after the effective date hereinabove specified.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
 SECTION 5. PUBLICATON: The City Clerk is hereby instructed to publish this
 Ordinance in pamphlet form as required by law.
