PROCLAMATION IN SUPPORT OF THE LASALLE COUNTY STATE'S ATTORNEY AND THE LASALLE COUNTY SHERIFF IN REGARD TO THE LEGAL CHALLENGE TO THE STATUTE COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "SAFE-T" ACT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oglesby is aware of the efforts of Joseph Navarro, the State's Attorney of LaSalle County and Adam Diss, Sheriff of LaSalle County in regard to the Illinois Statute commonly known as the "SAFE-T" Act, Illinois Public Act 101-652, hereinafter the "SAFE-T" Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oglesby deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Oglesby and the public in general to provide an expression of support of the LaSalle County State's Attorney and the Sheriff of LaSalle County in regard to the legal challenge as to certain aspects of the "SAFE-T" Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OGLESBY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That the above referenced recitals are hereby made a part of the proclaimed portion of this proclamation.

SECTION TWO: That the Oglesby City Council does hereby provide this Proclamation of Support of the efforts of the State's Attorney of LaSalle County and the Sheriff of LaSalle County in regard to their legal challenge to the statute commonly known as the State of Illinois "SAFE-T" Act, more specifically known as Illinois Public Act 101-652, though the City Council of the City of Oglesby also recognizes that this Proclamation of Support has no jurisdictional binding legal effect.
