ORDINANCE NO 1283-021825

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A GRANT OF EASEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OGLESBY AND ROBERT G. AND KAY E. MARINICIC AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SUCH GRANT OF EASEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Oglesby, LaSalle County, Illinois, operates its sewerage system ("the system") and in accordance with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-137-1 and the Local Government Debt Reform Act, 30 ILCS 350/1, et seq. ("collectively the Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Oglesby, LaSalle County, Illinois (the "Corporate Authorities") have determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the public health, safety, and welfare to improve the system; and,

WHEREAS, the City has engaged the services of Chamlin and Associates to design a new sewage treatment plant for the City; and

WHEREAS, in order to construct and maintain said new sewage treatment plant and outflow sewer the City needs to acquire permanent easements from Robert G. and Kay E. Marincic for the property described in and on the terms and conditions set forth in a Grant of Easement, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OGLESBY, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The findings and determinations set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are hereby made findings and determinations of the City Council of the City of Oglesby and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if set forth in full.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Council of the City of Oglesby hereby accepts and approves the Grant of Easement between the City of Oglesby and Robert G. and Kay E. Marincic, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A".

Section 3. By this Ordinance, the Mayor of the City of Oglesby is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest and seal the Grant of Easement between the City of Oglesby and Robert G. and Kay E. Marincic, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A".

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

<u>Section 5.</u> The City Clerk is hereby instructed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form as required by law.

GRANTORS, ROBERT G. MARINCIC and KAY E. MARINCIC, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid, DO HEREBY GRANT to the GRANTEE, the CITY OF OGLESBY, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, an Illinois Municipal Corporation, and to its successors and assigns, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, PERPETUAL EASEMENTS on, over, under and through the following-described real estate Tracts, for the purpose of constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, removing and renewing a sanitary and storm outfall sewer and flowage therefrom all at GRANTEE'S sole cost and expense, to wit:

Tract #1 (Flowage Easement):

A STRIP OF LAND 125 FEET IN WIDTH 62.5 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE PROPOSED OUTFALL SEWER LOCATED WITHIN THE BNSF RAILWAY'S (FORMERLYU CHICAGO, BURLINGTON & QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY) 100.0 FOOT WIDE L&s JUNCTION TO LASALLE, ILLINOIS BRANCH LLINE LOCATED IN THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 25,, TOWNSHIP 33 NORTH, RANGE 1 ESST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ALL SITUATED IN THE CITY OF OGLESBY, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS. GRANTOR.

Tract 2 (Access Easement):

33 FOOT WIDE INGRESS AND EGRESS EASEMENT IN THE NORTH HALF AND IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 33 NORTH, RANGE 1 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, 16.5 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED CENTERLINE; BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF

THE EAST LINE OF THE THIRTY FOOT TRAIL, (60 FOOT UTILITY & INGRESS AND EGRESS EASEMENT) AS SHOWN ON THE FINAL PLAT OF STONE BLUFF TERRACE, RECORED AS DOC. NO. 2010-19481 AT THE LASALLE COUNTY RECORDERS OFFICE AND THE EXISTING DRIVE, THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF SAID DRIVE TO A POINT WHERE THE DRIVE HEADS SOUTHERLY AND A PATH CONTINUES SOUTHEASTERLY PARALLELING THE VERMILLION RIVER, THENCE CONTINUE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG SAID PATH TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE CITY OF OGLESBYS OUTFALL SEWER, ITS POINT OF TERMINATION ALL SITUATED IN THE CITY OGLESBY, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Grantor herein may make use of the Easement Tract, so long as such use does not interfere with the rights herein granted, or create a hazardous condition, except that Grantor herein, their successors and assigns, shall make no excavation on the Easement Tract, except in such manner so as not to disturb or interfere with the facilities to be located therein or access rights thereto, nor shall Grantor place or erect any buildings on the Easement Tract.

Grantor further agrees that Grantee and its agents, successors and/or assigns may, at all reasonable times and without interference to Grantor's use of their remaining property adjacent to the Easement Tract, go on, over and across the Easement Tract when necessary to do so in furtherance of this Grant of Easement. In the event of any destruction of any improvements of Grantor's by Grantee, Grantee shall repair and restore any such improvements to the same or better condition and/or shall reimburse Grantee for any damage or loss.

The easements and rights herein granted, together with the obligations hereby imposed, are appurtenant to and shall run with title to all or any portion of the Easement Tract and the adjacent land owned by Grantee and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of Grantor and Grantee and their respective grantees, successors, assigns, mortgagees, ground lessees, tenants, occupants and any person or persons claiming under or through any of them.

Grantee does hereby agree to protect, indemnify and hold Grantor harmless from and against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees and litigation expenses) arising from injury or death of any person or damage or loss of property occurring on or due to the use of the Easement Tract by Grantee or Grantee's officers, employees, agents or representatives, and arising out of the operation, maintenance and use of the utilities placed therein.

Grantee agrees that the above-mentioned rights and its use of the Easement Tract shall, at all times be in compliance with all applicable environmental laws, rules and regulations, and in no event shall hazardous or toxic waste materials be on the Easement Tract.
