

PROJECT: Oglesby Wastewater treatment plant ESTIMATED COST: Phase 1, \$23M; Phase 2, TBD FINANCED BY: Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund COMPLETION DATE: December 31, 2028

Construction of the City of Oglesby's new wastewater treatment plant was financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project will replace the outdated plant and addressed concerns identified by the IEPA. Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in Oglesby by allowing for efficient, effective treatment, prepare the City for future development or regulations and replace the outfall sewer. The improvements were mandated by the EPA in 2021. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: Water.
