



City of Oglesby, IL Utility Permit For Work in Right-of-Way & Service Installations

4. Job Location

- A. All work must be in accordance with the City of Oglesby standards, ordinances, adopted standards specifications, codes and all supplements and amendment thereto. Traffic control devices and measures shall conform to Illinois Department of Transportation Standards for Traffic Control and must be approved by the City Engineer. **Work must be completed within 90 days of approval of this permit, unless otherwise specified in Section 19, below.**
- B. Contractor(s) must contact J.U.L.I.E (811) or (1-800-892-0123) to locate and mark-out underground utilities for any work under this Permit. Contractor(s) is(are) responsible for protecting all utilities, conduit, wiring, and their apparatuses within and adjacent to the project/area of work. Utilities damaged by construction must be restored within twenty-four (24) hours of damage.
- C. Contractor shall give forty-eight (48) hours' notice prior to commencement of work and the request for final inspection. Call (815-883-3389) for notice of work commencement and to schedule final inspections.
- D. Contractor shall identify, protect, and preserve all survey monuments. Surveying shall be performed by a Licensed Land Surveyor licensed in the State of Illinois or a Registered Professional Civil Engineer authorized to practice Land Surveying registered in the State of Illinois and shall conform to the requirements of the Land Surveyor's Act.
- E. Temporary storage of material within the public right-of-way shall be in accordance with the City of Oglesby's Codes/Ordinances.
- F. Any work performed without the benefit of a City inspection shall be subject to rejection, and cause for removal, and replacement at Contractor's expense.
- G. All permits shall include a location map of the project, plan sheet(s), and description of work, outlining the improvements.
- H. All utilities to be retired shall include a location map, plan sheet(s), and description of work.
- I. Service connections shall only be required to submit a description of work, size of service line, bury depth, and location map with address.
- J. All contractors must register with the City of Oglesby. Improvements shall not commence until all contractors are registered. Contractors found not to be registered will be in violation of the permit and subject to fines per the City of Oglesby Ordinances.
- K. Payment of the \$250 permit fee is due prior to the final permit issuance and commencement of construction.
