Check out the new online bill pay service. As of April 1, 2026 PSN will no longer be active so we encourage residents who currently use PSN to create an account using the link or QR code below. Community Connect allows you to not only view your current bill but also past bills. Online payments made by credit/debit card will be charged an additional 3.5% fee. To avoid processing fees and still take advantage of the convenience of paying anytime anywhere, payments made through ACH will be done at NO additional cost.

- **BURNING:** Burning hours are 8 am until 6 pm on Thursday, Friday and Saturday - March 15 through December 31.
- **UTV/Golf Cart Registration:** UTV stickers are available at City Hall. To renew your registration, you will need a 2026 Liability Waiver (available at City Hall), copy of valid driver's license, and proof of insurance. To register a UTV/golf cart, you will need an inspection by the Oglesby Police Dept. (inspection papers are available at City Hall). The fee to register and/or renew a sticker is \$50.




Permits and Contractor's info here
